# **BLUE JAYS ORGANIZATION**

## **VOLUNTEER SPOT JOB DESCRIPTIONS**

## KITCHEN PREP: 7pm – 9pm

(Two people sign up) This spot is for the **NIGHT BEFORE** the home games. You meet the Kitchen Coordinator at Bentley Field's Concession Stand. The Kitchen Coordinator will direct you to do different jobs needed in assisting him getting things ready for the next days game. Unloading goods collected and bought from the truck and putting them away in the kitchen. Getting appliances set up, items into coolers, etc.

### **SET UP:**

Game Day for home games. Meet at the Bentley Field Garage (opposite side of the bleacher from the concession stand). Meet with the Field Coordinator and assist in setting the field up, so it is game day ready. Once that is done, you head over to the kitchen so you can help the Kitchen Coordinator with any set up needs that remain.

### **EXPEDITOR:**

Works in the kitchen to ensure all is running smoothly. Checks on stock, helping where needed or where there may be a rush or a shortfall of volunteers. Responsible for condiment area and napkins while making sure area is clean. Make sure warmer is stocked of foods needed and refrigerator is full. Take direction from the kitchen coordinator for the shift.

### **GRILL:**

Work the grill grilling hamburgers, hotdogs (etc.) to ensure plenty of grilled food is prepared during the game as needed.

### WRAP AND RUN:

Wrap the foods that come off the grill and put into the warmers for the kitchen window. Running between the concession area and the grill getting any food that is done and or giving the grill any raw foods needed to get grilled.

### **KITCHEN WINDOW:**

Work the window taking orders. You are responsible for taking cash/making change or being able to take a CC and use the square.

### RUNNER/FLOAT:

This person's job will vary week to week. You may need to run to the store for any needs that arise. You must be able to drive with a vehicle. The Kitchen Coordinator will dictate what jobs are needed the day of the game.

## 50/50:

(Two people sign up) Meet at the kitchen where you will receive a bucket of tickets and an apron. You are responsible for walking up and down the bleachers getting people to participate in the 50/50 raffle. The more fun and outgoing you are with this, the more successful the raffle will be. This is done the first half of the game. You are responsible for counting the money and getting the tickets up to the announcer's booth for a drawing during half time. After the drawing is done, return the money, buckets and aprons to the Kitchen Coordinator.

### **CARETAKER:**

You are responsible for emptying all garbage bins and replacing the bags within the concession area and in the stands, sweeping up any major messes, picking up garbage around the black top surrounding the concession stand, picking up both restrooms and stocking them with TP and soap. (see page 3)

### **DOWN MARKER:**

Stand on the visiting teams sideline keeping track of the downs throughout the game and marking where the line of scrimmage is.

#### **CHAINS:**

Stand on the visiting team sideline and keep track of the 10 yards they need for a first down.

### **ANNOUNCER:**

EXPERIENCE IS NOT MANDATORY, BUT STRONGLY RECOMMENDED! You are announcing the game from announcing the teams to the play by play. You must be able to speak clearly. You also need to be able to pump up the crowd appropriately and at proper times. Be able to read off any announcements needed during the game. You must be able to multi-task during the game.

### **SPOTTER:**

This person is watching the game and letting the announcer know who ran the ball and who made the tackle. Must be able to read the numbers on the boys jerseys.

### **SCOREBOARD:**

This person is responsible for starting and stopping the clock per refs signal, keeping track of the score, what down it is, time outs and what quarter it is.

### **CLEAN UP:**

(6 people needed) Work together as a group to clean up under, around and on the bleachers, the parking lot area, the field area and anywhere that is needed to ensure Bentley Field is clean and ready to go for the next day or weeks games.

# **Volunteer Caretaker Responsibilities**

- During the game (your time slot), your assignment is to walk around to each area and make sure that Bentley (ie. concessions, stands, bathrooms...) is in good condition and there are no safety hazards which could cause people to slip
  - If something doesn't look right, or is a terrible mess, or you need help, see a field coordinator or a director for questions
- All supplies (garbage bags, gloves, toilet paper, paper towels, soap...) are located in the garage (where we do weigh-ins)
  - All garbage goes into the dumpster located near the front gate
- Check all garbage cans located by concession stand and along the stands (between track and stands). Empty if they are ¾ full. Please leave an extra bag hanging on the side of the can
- If the returnables cans are ¾ full, empty the returnables and place the ¾ full bag in corner near the dumpster
- Check with kitchen to see if they have any garbage cans that they need emptied
- Check both bathrooms and restock as necessary:
  - Hand soap
  - Toilet paper
  - Paper towel
    - Empty small garbage cans and main garbage cans in bathroom if ¾ full
- At halftime only (after cheer halftime performance): check the field garbage cans
  that are located near the football player benches (on both sides of the field) and
  empty if ¾ full. Please leave an extra bag hanging on the side of the can
- Please help pick up garbage that is on the ground around concession stands or in the stands
